SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

UNDERGRADUATES

GVSU International Scholarship

Total: \$6,000 (approximately)
Criteria: All undergraduate
international students admitted
to Grand Valley will automatically
receive this scholarship to reduce
tuition to the Michigan resident rate.
The scholarship has an approximate
four-year value of \$24,000. The
scholarship is awarded at admission.

International Merit Scholarship

Total: \$2,500
Criteria: Scholarship decisions are
based on a review of the information
in the application, including an
essay, academic information, and
extracurricular activities. Students
who submit an application for fall
admission by October 15 are eligible for
this scholarship. Only students on F1
status are eligible for this scholarship.

GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS

(up to full tuition)

Highly qualified graduate students
may be considered for full tuition
graduate assistantships. Students
must apply for these awards after
admission to the program. For more

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed international application at gvsu.edu/apply.
- Official, original academic transcripts and degree certificates from all secondary schools and universities that you have attended. All documents must be translated into English.
- English proficiency requirement. One of the following:
 - Duolingo: 105
 - TOEFL: 80
 - IELTS: 6.5
 - PTE: 53
 - SAT 510 or above in Evidence-Based Reading and Writing
 - ACT 18 or above in English
 - Advance Placement (AP): 3 or above in English
 - International Baccalaureate (IB): 5 or above on Higher Level exam in English A or English B
 - MELAB (Michigan English Language Assessment Battery) 77 or above

Exemptions: Students from countries where English is the native/primary language, or who have been attending an international secondary school for at least two years where English is the primary language of instruction. However, a test may be required at the discretion of the Admissions and Recruitment Office.

- Write a one- to two-page personal statement on your goals and reasons for wanting to attend Grand Valley. Required for undergraduate admission and select graduate programs.

FOR GRADUATE APPLICANTS

While college expenses vary with each student, this chart provides an estimation of the annual cost to attend Grand Valley.
