Access and Use of Slides and Digital Images

- Digital images available on the GVSU Visual Resources Library (GLEAN©) will be username and password protected. Access is limited to users with GVSU authentication.
- Acknowledgement of copyright ownership and permission accompanies each image.
- Digital images may be downloaded for class papers, and class/seminar/conference
  presentations and other fair use. The downloaded images should be augmented with
  available metadata, and the size should be suitable for full-screen projection or
  display on a personal computer or mobile device, but not larger.
- Digital images can not be downloaded to put on personal websites and should not be used for commercial purposes, including but not limited to television, print media, video disc or videotape broadcasts without written permission of the copyright holder.

Producing Digital Images from Copyrighted Bookplates

- Digital images produced for the collection will not be reproduced, republished, or widely disseminated. Only one copy of an image from a copyrighted work will be made.
- When licensable digital images of acceptable quality are available from a commercial source, every effort will be made to purchase the digital images and licenses adhered to the images.
- In those cases where there is no indication that there are separate copyright owners for plates or figures apart from the copyright owner of the text of a book, not more than 10% or 15 images, whichever is less, will be produced as digital images.
