## General Education Requirements and Time to Graduation:

Refer to the General Education requirements in the General Education Handbook. The complete BFA degree is 131 total credits including general education and all art department requirements. Spread across 8 semesters, this results in an average of 16.375 credits a semester. While each University requirement is distinct and important, some can be fulfilled simultaneously. It is possible to reduce total credits, semester course loads, and time to graduation.

Options for reducing total credits, semester course loads, and time to graduation:

- 1. Some General Education courses fulfill more than one requirement.
- 2. General Education or studio requirements can be fulfilled in summer study abroad programs, or studio intensives.
- 3. General education coursework can be completed in Spring/Summer sessions.
- 4. Internships can be taken in the summer.
- 5. You may opt to extend your time in school to 4.5 or 5 years.
